Whether her department was informed of or received any complaints that any educators in schools failing to complete the syllabus in any subject before the final matriculation examination in 2005; if so, (a) what steps did she take (i) to ensure that this was an accurate reflection of the facts and (ii) against such educators and (b) what are the relevant details in respect of each province.

REPLY:

I have neither been informed nor have I received any complaints of schools failing to complete the syllabus prior to the matric examination in 2005.
