These Regulations may be cited as the *Regulations Pertaining to the National Curriculum Statement Grades R-12* and will come into effect on the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*. The offering of Mandarin at Second Additional Language level, Grades 4-12 will, however, commence in the month of January, following the year of approval.
