Education Facility Management System (EFMS) Report as at 21 August 2023

The **Education Facility Management System (EFMS)** is the new system utilised by the Department of Basic Education (DBE) to capture school infrastructure information which replaces the **National Education Infrastructure Management System (NEIMS)** which was previously used. The system assists the DBE in monitoring the progress made in provisioning of infrastructure to the schools and assists in identifying shortages or backlogs of infrastructure needed at schools. The school infrastructure is provided based on the **REGULATION RELATING TO MINIMUM UNIFORM NORMS AND STANDARDS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE**, gazette by minister of Basic Education Honourable Angelina Matsie Motshekga on 29 November 2013 and the objective of the regulation are:

- To provide minimum uniform norms and standards for public school infrastructure;
- To ensure that there is compliance with the minimum uniform norms and standards in the design and construction of new schools and additions, alterations and improvements to schools which exist when these regulations are published; and
- To provide for timeframes within which school infrastructure backlogs must be eradicated.

This report outlines the overview summary of school infrastructure across all 9 provinces as at 21 August 2021, with the focus only on public ordinary operational schools (i.e. a public school that is not a special school) and provide summary statistics on:

- Access to electricity and the type of electricity the schools has;
- Access to water and the type of water supply the schools has;
- The type of ablution the schools has;
- The type of the fence and security the schools has;
- The number of schools with and without library and whether the library has books or not;
- The number of schools with and without laboratory;
- The number of schools with and without computer center;
- The type of sports facilities the schools has; and
- The type of communication the school utilizes and how the internet is utilised.

NOTE: The DBE is currently conducting the school condition assessment to update the information .
