

## **ECD CENSUS 2021** BY THE NUMBERS

The Department of Basic Education in partnership with the LEGO Foundation commissioned the first Early Childhood Development (ECD) Census to collect data on all Early Learning Programmes (ELPs) in the country. The data will facilitate a better understanding of the ECD landscape in South Africa and inform more targeted resource allocation to improve outcomes.

Data was collected between August 2021 and February 2022
