# TRIAL ORIENTATION

## Background and Purpose

Reading is a complex and non-linear process that engages different linguistic components for its development

- **Phonetics and Phonology:** speech sounds and their relation to orthography
- **Morphology:** study of the smallest units of meaning in a word
- **Semantics:** how language conveys meaning
- **Syntax:** study of the language's grammar
- **Pragmatics:** appropriate choice of words in context

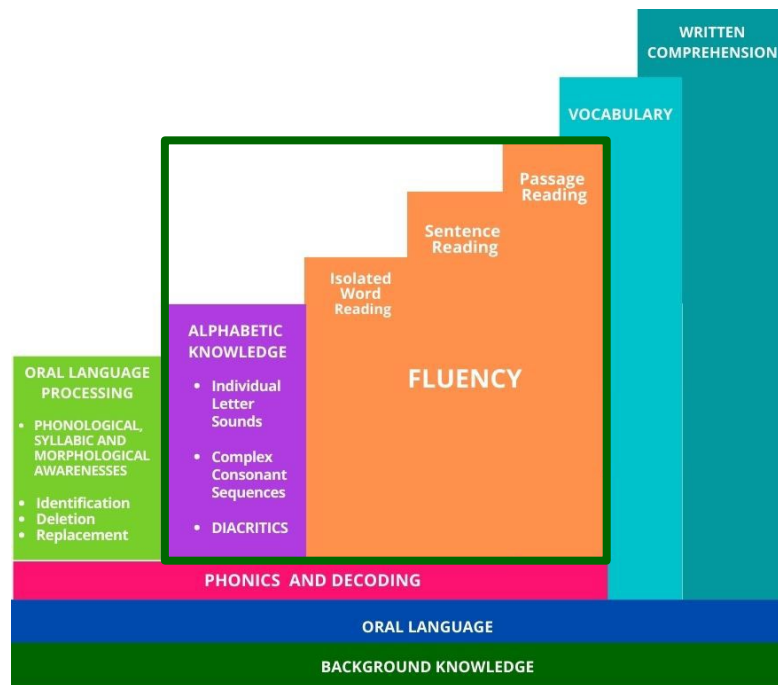
Depending on a language's structure the salience and interaction of these components vary in the reading development journey.



# LITERACY BENCHMARKS

## Establishment of Early Grade Reading Benchmarks

### Considerations for Precursor Skills to Benchmark



- Predicts/ facilitates later written comprehension
- Explicitly taught and preferably attainable (constrained skill) in the Foundation Phase
- Metric that is readily understandable and useful for different users
- Appropriate across South African educational context (e.g. linguistic diversity and socio-economic landscape)



## TRiALORIENTATION

### Background and Purpose

### Funda Uphumelele Reading Study and National Survey

- **EXPLORE** the hypotheses that there is relationship between certain linguistic domains (Morphological Awareness and Semantics) and key literacy outcomes (Letter Sound Knowledge, Isolated Word Reading, Oral Reading Fluency, ORF Comprehension and Written Comprehension).
- **ENGAGE** with various implicated DBE Programme Managers on the preliminary findings, drawn implications, hypotheses, and recommendations
- **DEVELOP** resources and guidelines for wider sectoral use
