FOREWORD



I am pleased to present the 2014 National Senior Certificate (NSC) Subject Report for the Northern Cape Province. This report is one of the nine provincial Subject Reports compiled to provide a comprehensive account of the subject performance in each of the schools in the province. This report has been compiled and made available to all the relevant officials as part of the initiative of the Department of Basic Education, to equip curriculum planners, curriculum implementers and district officials with all the necessary information that they require to effectively support the schools in their jurisdiction. This report should be read in conjunction with both the Diagnostic Report and the School Performance Report to enable a more holistic interpretation of learner performance in the individual

schools and collectively in the district.

Provinces, districts and schools have made commendable efforts to co-ordinate and implement a variety of systemic interventions to ensure adequate teacher preparedness and learner readiness for the 2014 NSC examination. The decrease of 2.4% in the overall performance as reflected in the national pass rate, can be explained by the policy changes that were implemented in 2014, which I firmly believe will produce positive outcomes in the medium to long-term. The policy changes introduced are intended to infuse quality into the system, based on the raising of

standards and higher cognitive demands reflected in the curriculum, design and structure of question papers. Therefore minor fluctuations in learner performance would be expected. This does not detract from the overall upward trajectory envisaged for the system, and the NSC results over the past three years have illustrated a stability and maturation of the schooling system.

The 2014 NSC results for the eleven gateway subjects indicate that Accounting, Agricultural Sciences, Geography and Life Sciences are showing a steady increase in the percentage of candidates who have achieved 30% and above. However, noticeable decreases in the percentage of candidates that achieved 30% and above have been observed in Business Studies, Economics and Mathematical Literacy. There has also been a slight decline in the percentage of candidates achieving 30% and above in both English First Additional Language and History. In the case of Mathematics and Physical Sciences, there was a decline in performance in the examination results, which in turn prevented the attainment of the targets set in the Annual Performance Plan. We are taking serious note of these observations and our Provincial Education Departments (PEDs) and districts will reflect on these performances with the schools and refine their District Improvement Plans so that we can respond more appropriately to improving learner performance in these subjects.

Let us continue to strive for better learner outcomes and continue to improve performance in all the NSC subjects offered by candidates.

1. INTRODUCTION

This report is part of the on-going initiatives by the Department of Basic Education (DBE) to improve the use of the National Senior Certificate (NSC) results as a tool for school improvement. In this report the subject results of all schools in the province are compiled into a single document, which allows for easy access by all officials, based either at the provincial or district levels, that engage with school performance. This report focuses on the performance of schools across districts in the eleven key subjects. In order to ensure a comparative analysis, subject performance data for both 2013 and 2014 are included.

The Department has published the following four reports on the 2014 National Senior Certificate that should be read together:

- (a) The National Senior Certificate Technical Report;
- (b) Schools Performance Report;
- (c) Schools Subject Report; and
- (d) National Diagnostic Report.

These four reports target the different levels of the system and each report has a different focus.

The National Senior Certificate Technical Report provides information on the national mandate of the Department of Basic Education and uses the National Senior Certificate examination results to evaluate the achievement of the national mandate. The Schools Performance Report provides data on the overall performance of the schools in terms of the overall pass rate of each of the schools. The Schools Subject Report provides data on the performance of each of the schools in the country in eleven key subjects. The National Diagnostic Report evaluates performance in selected subjects by highlighting the areas of weakness in each of these subjects and the remedial measures that need to be adopted at the school level to improve the performance in these subjects. These four reports provide a holistic evaluation of the National Senior Certificate.

2. SCOPE OF THE SCHOOLS SUBJECT REPORT

The Schools Subject Report provides performance data on eleven key subjects: Accounting, Agricultural Sciences, Business Studies, Economics, English First Additional Language (FAL), Geography, History, Life Sciences, Mathematical Literacy, Mathematics and Physical Sciences. For the first time this year, there are nine individual provincial reports which presents the National Senior Certificate (NSC) examination performance data for 2013 and 2014.

Candidates' performance in the key subjects at a national level over the last four years precedes the summary table of candidates' performance by district in these subjects within this report. Each provincial report provides the candidates' performance per subject, per individual school, within each district, so that every school will be able to evaluate the performance in the specific subject in 2013 and 2014.

3. UTILISATION OF THE SCHOOLS SUBJECT REPORT

This report may be used by school managers, subject advisors, curriculum specialists and district planners to do a quick comparative analysis of the performance of schools within a ward, circuit, cluster or district. The report would also help them to evaluate the impact of the changes in the revised curriculum and the possible impact on results in the subjects that have undergone substantial changes in content, cognitive demand, and design of question papers in 2014. This exercise will be useful for designing contextually appropriate interventions at school, district and provincial levels, to focus on the subjects that require additional support and intervention in the new school year.

The schools subject data provides the opportunity for school managers, subject advisors and curriculum planners to delve beneath the surface and identify any patterns of correlation in learner performance across the key subjects. Schools that perform well in one subject should also perform at an equivalent level in other subjects e.g. Mathematics and Physical Sciences. Where there is a lack of correlation between related subjects, further investigations must be carried out by subject advisors to establish the reason for this non-alignment of performance. This may quite often point to competency levels of teachers, difference in the cohort of learners, or other resource limitations. The overall school performance results usually mask the performance of the teachers, and individual teachers could then escape from the accountability chain. With the Schools Report, accountability is re-instated to the teacher.
