- 1. Grootfontein Agricultural College is a Tertiary Institution that falls under the Department of Rural Development and Agrarian Reform and offers tertiary courses in Agriculture. It's not a high school.
- 2. Hoerlandbouskool Marlow is an Afrikaans medium Agricultural School and offers tuition in all subjects in Afrikaans. Currently, Black learners are studying Agricultural Studies offered through the medium of Afrikaans.
- 3. The Eastern Cape has a total of 16 (sixteen) other Agricultural High Schools where Agricultural Studies is currently being piloted from 2021and the medium of instruction is English in all of them.
