Response

(a) The following progress has been made to date:

(i) **2349** schools have been provided with sanitation through **Sanitation Appropriate for Education initiative**;

(ii) **310** new schools have been built, **1249** schools provided with water facilities, **1046** schools provided with sanitation facilities and **373** schools provided with electricity through **Accelerated School Infrastructure Delivery Initiative**; and

(b) **R13.2** billion has been spent on infrastructure backlogs at schools since 2011 to date.
