DUTIES: The incumbent will be responsible to provide effective strategic leadership in Dramatic Arts, Visual Arts, Music, Dance and Design in the education system; develop, implement and maintain curriculum policies related to the Arts subjects in the FET phase; Monitor, evaluate and appraise the implementation of curriculum and assessment; Innovate, monitor, manage, support and evaluate existing policies, regulations and research projects related to Arts Subjects; Liaise with provincial departments of education to render professional assistance in capacity building related to learning, teaching and assessment in Dramatic

Arts, Visual Arts, Music, Dance and Design; Conceptualise, design and manage projects for Dance, Design, Dramatic Arts, Music and Visual Arts to improve learning outcomes; Engage with relevant role players and stakeholders and support the development of materials for Dance, Design, Dramatic Arts, Music and Visual Arts.
